## Our Mission

## Our Programs

Teenwork Partners' work is built around **five pillar programs** designed to prepare teens for success in the workplace and help businesses build strong, more reliable workforces:

1. **Professional Development Training** – Teens progress through three levels of training, earning certifications in key workforce skills such as communication, professionalism, leadership, and collaboration.
2. **Mentorship & Job Matching** – Certified teens are paired with mentors and gain access to exclusive job boards and volunteer placements.
3. **Business Partnership Solutions** – We partner with employers through a membership model that strengthens hiring, onboarding, and retention while connecting them with certified, job-ready teens.
4. **Teen Advisory Council** – A group of youth leaders who help shape TWP programs, serve as ambassadors, and develop their own leadership and career skills.
5. **Career Exposure & Networking** – Job fairs, panels, and industry events connect teens directly with local professionals and employers.
